CANDIDATE FORM - 2009 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Nominating Committee needs your cooperation in securing the best possible nominees for Texas State USBC Association Officers and Directors. Much consideration should be given to a prospective officer's ability and willingness to serve, before they are nominated. The following are the eligibility requirements:

Note: Currently there are four [4] Director positions up for election if elected the term would be a three-year term. The Office of President and Second Vice President are also up for election. See note # 5

A candidate for the board must be:

1. A member in good standing of the association at the time of election and throughout their term.
2. Elected or appointed without regard to race, color, religion, gender, disability, national origin, or age, other than the minimum age of 14, unless state laws mandate a specific age, and be reasonably representative of the membership.
 - a. Any member of the board authorized to sign contracts or acting as a signatory on association accounts must be a minimum age of 18.
 - b. At least 20% of the board must be represented by youth and elected by and from the Youth Committee.
 - c. A maximum of three bowling center proprietors may serve on the board at one time. A proprietor is an individual who is the owner, partner, or corporate officer of a bowling center or group of bowling centers. Excluded from the definition of proprietor is an individual who owns 25% or less of the equity shares, or who is inactive in the management of the bowling center and remains so during a term as an officer or director.
3. Served as a delegate at the TXSUSBC council of delegate annual meetings or as an officer or director of a local USBC board of directors for three or more years including the year of nomination. Past service with an ABC, WIBC or TYABA organization will be considered.
4. Must have served as a member of the local association board of directors.
5. In addition to the above stated eligibility requirements to serve as a director, a nominee for an officer position must have served on the Texas State USBC Association, Inc. Board of Directors as a director for at least 2 years.
6. Must be a current member of a local USBC association and a Register Volunteer of USBC.
