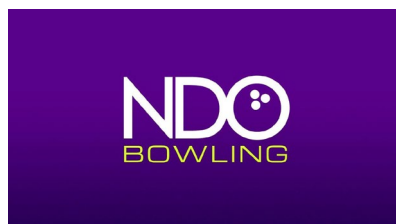

This tournament is open to male USBC members certified within the State of Texas who are 50 years and older as of the date of participation (January 25, 2020). Any non-Texas resident must purchase a card within Texas and have a minimum of a 12 game average in a current league certified with a Texas Association.

The Texas State USBC Senior Masters tournament is an individual competition based on total pin fall and is conducted on a scratch basis. The tournament will consist of:

- **Qualifying Round:** Each entrant will bowl eight (8) games across sixteen (16) lanes in one eight (8) game block. Tournament Management will assign lanes by blind draw. Each bowler's eight game total will be used to determine the qualifiers advancing to the semi-final round. A minimum of sixteen (16) bowlers, or one for each eight entries, whichever is greater, will advance to the
- **Semi-Final Round** of four (4) games across eight (8) lanes. Each bowler's twelve (12) game total will be used to determine the eight (8) contestants advancing to the
- **Final Round** eight (8) games of match play
- **Super Senior Feature–Review Tournament Rule 5** for qualifying procedures for Super Seniors advancement

The Texas State Senior Masters is an individual competition based on total pin fall and is conducted on a scratch basic. This tournament is open to male USBC members certified within the State of Texas who are 50 years and older as of the date of participation (January 30, 2021). Any non-Texas resident must purchase a card within Texas and have a minimum of a 12 game average in a current league certified with a Texas Association.

The Texas State Senior Masters is an individual competition based on total pin fall and is conducted on a scratch basis. The event is open to male members of USBC participating in The State Senior Masters tournament is used as a qualifier to determine a representative for the USBC Senior Masters Tournament. The Champion will be eligible to have a paid entry for the National event. In the event the Champion is unable to participate, the Texas State USBC Association will follow its policy for representation at the National event.

Attire: Participants must wear long pants and a bowling shirt, dress shirt, or sport shirt; no headwear or tank shirts will be allowed. Jeans with no holes may be worn. Contestants not in compliance with the attire rule may be subject to disqualification.

Contestants will be governed by the rules of the USBC, plus the following provisions:

1. Entry fee will be \$200.00 (\$150.00 prize; \$35.00 lineage; \$15.00 expense). The lineage and expense fees include lineage in the semi-final and final rounds, promotional and operational costs. After reserved entry closing date of January 19, entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the official practice session prior to Qualifying Round, with an additional fee of \$25 (to be added to the prize fund), and subject to availability of lanes. (Bowlers will be scheduled no more than three (3) to a lane and six (6) to a pair of lanes.)
2. Participant will check in with USBC membership card at least 45 minutes prior to qualifying squad.
3. After an entry has been accepted and confirmed, fees cannot be transferred without the consent of Tournament Management. Substitutes should be reported to Tournament Management as soon as possible, but no later than 45 minutes prior to qualifying squad on site at the tournament office. Entry fee is not refundable.
4. Qualifying Round – Each entrant will bowl eight (8) games across sixteen (16) lanes in one eight game block. Each bowler's eight (8) game total will be used to determine the qualifiers advancing to the semi-final round. A minimum of sixteen (16) bowlers or one for eight entries (1/8), whichever is higher, will advance to the Semi-Final Round of four (4) games across eight (8) lanes. Each bowler's twelve game total will be used to determine the eight (8) contestants advancing to Final Round of match play.
5. Super Senior Feature – Based on a minimum of 12 Super Senior entries
 - A minimum of four super senior participants (65+) will advance to semi-finals and two super senior participants will advance to final match play.
 - If scores do not qualify in top 16, the highest scores by four (4) Super Seniors (65+) will by-pass and advance to semi-finals.
 - If score in semi-finals do not qualify in top 8, the highest score by two (2) Super Seniors (65+) will bypass and advance to Final Round of match play.
6. If a bowler is not present at the scheduled time for any portion of the semi-final and/or final rounds, an alternate bowler will be given the opportunity to replace him in the schedule. The alternate bowler will be the next highest bowler for the qualifying round. If time does not permit locating the next highest bowler, the alternate bowler will be the next highest qualifier available.
7. An entrant may be disqualified for the following while participating in an event:
 - An infraction of the rules
 - Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the tournament
 - Use of foreign substance which comes in contact with the approaches of the lanes.

Any infraction of the rules will be cause for immediate disqualification and removal from the tournament. Disqualification of an individual shall result in forfeiture of the entry fee and any right to prize money and/or awards.
8. If the final position in the qualifying and/or semi-final rounds should result in a tie, or there is a tie for first place following the final position match, the following procedure will apply:
 - One game will be bowled immediately after completion of the respective round (qualifying round; semi-final round, or a tie for first place tie following position match.)
 - Bowlers will draw for starting lane
 - Bowler on odd numbered lane will start the roll-off
 - In the event a tie exists after this match, two (2) extra frames will be bowled (9th & 10th frames).

In the event of a tie, failure of any contestant to be available for the roll-off will constitute forfeiture.

FINAL ROUND:

9. Pairing for the initial round of matches will be according to a prearranged format displayed at the tournament site.
10. All carryover of pin fall from qualifying will be dropped and finalists will start from zero.
11. All finalists will bowl eight games – seven (7) games of head to head match play using a prearranged 8 team schedule and one (1) final position game.
12. All finalists will receive a thirty (30) pin bonus for each game won, and the bonus will be added to his total score. If a match ends in a tie, each contestant will receive a fifteen (15) pin bonus.
13. There will be a short break at the end of the seventh game before lane assignments are made for the eighth position game.
14. In the event an alternate replaces a finalist during match play competition, all prize money earned will be divided equally between the finalist and the alternate following the completion of the tournament competition.
15. Tournament Management shall have the authority to decide any other matters pertaining to the operation of the tournament not covered by the above rules.

ENTRY FORM

I agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress as well as the additional rules published for the Texas State USBC Senior Masters Tournament, which include the following:

- Entry fee may not be transferred without the consent of Tournament Management
- Substitutes should be requested as soon as possible to Tournament Management, but no later than 45 minutes before qualifying squad on site at tournament office. Entry fees are not refundable.
- A minimum of sixteen (16) bowlers, or one for each eight entries (1/8), whichever is higher, (to include 4 Super Seniors) will advance to semi-final round Sunday, January 31. The eight (8) high bowlers (to include 2 Super Seniors) will advance into the final round Sunday, January 31. Qualifying scores will be based on total pinfall following each round – Qualifying and Semi-Final. See Tournament Rule 4 and 5.
